COMMENTARII CN. CORNELI LENTULI LEGATI PRO PRAETORE

I have undertaken the custody and mentorship of this province in order to help its development from its idle state to the status that meets the requirements for being classified as an active province of Nova Roma. My primary goal was to mentor a number of individuals who would then be able locally to continue the development of the province. Three citizens were particularly dedicated and eager in action, C. Marcius Augustinus, whom I recently appointed as my provincial quaestor, Cn. Duilius Fullo and M. Cassius Maro, whom I appointed as my scribes. Dulius is responsible for the Roman religious and cultural projects in the civic life of the province, Cassius is responsible for Roman military projects in the civic life of the province.

The first steps have been made in the process of reorganization. I have established contact with the local Legio XIV Gemina, and started talks about possible ways of cooperation. With my new staff, I have started preparations for our first provincial convention which has great promise.

We plan to contact all current members of the province and to survey their interests and possible involvement.

The work for a functioning province of Nova Roma in Lacus Magni is in its initial phase, but with our contact with a local legion, with an eager and great new staff, with our plans for a local convention, our hopes are high. I hope I can report more good news to the senate next time: I have confidence that I will be able to deliver.
