## COMMENTARII CN. CORNELI LENTULI QUAESTORIS PRO PRAETORE

Cn. Cornelius Lentulus quaestor pro praetore Novae Hispaniae Sex. Lucilio et A. Tulliae consulibus et senatui Rei Publicae Novae Romanae s. p. d.

Si valetis et res publica valet, nos et Nova Hispania valemus.

Most esteemed consuls and patres conscripti, similarly to Provincia Brasilia, the situation of Nova Roma in Provincia Nova Hispania is very difficult. As quaestor pro praetore of Nova Hispania, I succeeded to establish a good collaboration and unofficial partnership with the "Cultus Deorum de Costa Rica" otherwise known as "Tribus Opalina", a Roman religion group led by M'. Lucretius Braulio, our citizen. We are currently in negotiations about how to proceed to develop Provincia Nova Hispania, basing it on the Cultus Deorum de Costa Rica project. He needs to learn a lot about the working mechanisms of Nova Roma, and his community is very small, so our situation is not easy. Previously I have been working our praetorian senator M. Iulius Camillus, a provincial citizen, but he was called away from public service in Nova Roma, and we could not continue our plans.

What all this means for our province in Nova Hispania is that we have to continue our collaboration with "Cultus Deorum de Costa Rica". We have already held joint rituals and ceremonies, and we plan to continue this. However, I still need to find more ways to have our presence established in the region. Unfortunately, I could not locate any Roman reenactment groups or any other type of Roman societies in the countries of this province, which makes my work very difficult, but not impossible. I am not yet giving up on Provincia Nova Hispania, however, if there is no progress in the next period, either, I will recommend to abandon the province administratively, and to encourage locals in the future to build at least a core community before the area could be made a province in the future.
