Most esteemed consuls and conscript fathers of the senate, it is always Pannonia, my province of residence, where I can do the most, even though I was able, and continue to be able, to provide substantial help in the reorganization of other provinces due to my experience, connections and flagrant dedication to our sacred cause in Nova Roma.

Since most of the larger events in Pannonia are widely publicized and reported during the year, and since we have so many activities here that we might even be provide not only an annual but a weekly breakdown of all of our activities, I restrict myself in this report only to provide you with the most objective and succinct data, and the most important developments.

Regarding the expansion of the province, one of the good news is that I have established a new reenactment legion in Pannonia, the Cohors I Atilia, with P. Atilius Severus as its commander. We had deepened our partnership with the neighboring provinces, especially with Germania, Dacia and Thracia, with several common events and projects.

2-6 August, Q. Arrio (III) A. Tullia cos. – Kids’ legionary camp in Aquincum by our Cohors VI Carpathica

12 August, Q. Arrio (III) A. Tullia cos. – Wedding of a gladiator citizen of NR

27-29 August, Q. Arrio (III) A. Tullia cos. – Savaria Days and celebration of the Voltornalia festival of Nova Roma

4-5 September, Q. Arrio (III) A. Tullia cos. – Ludi Romani festival in Aquincum

Regarding other projects in Aquincum, with the initiative of our citizen and archaeology student Claudia Vibiana, we have been working on creating the most authentic presentation of Roman natural dyes. Our military display is developed under the academic quality control of our praefectus regionis et cohortis and archaeology student C. Villius Macro. Increased focus is now placed in Pannonia on the most authentic presentation in our Roman tools, clothes and all material items. Our connection to archaeologists and museum officials is deeper and better, and we are continue to enrich this network of connections.

I have been also working on establishing a land project with the potential of building not only temples or Roman military facilities but even an entire little Roman town. This project is being worked in cooperation of local landowner citizens of Nova Roman Pannonia.

In conclusion, I am happy and proud that our province in Pannonia is flourishing and serving as a model of cooperation between various legionary and gladiatorial groups and less “professional” citizens, our projects are ambitious and coordinated toward a direction which serve the universal goals of Nova Roma internationally. I would hope that someone else could replace me in my position as governor but my candidates have so far refused to volunteer for this complex and laborious duty. It is not easy to harmonize and coordinate between so many different people and groups, but, with the helps of the gods immortal, we have been successful, and we pray that we continue to be so.
